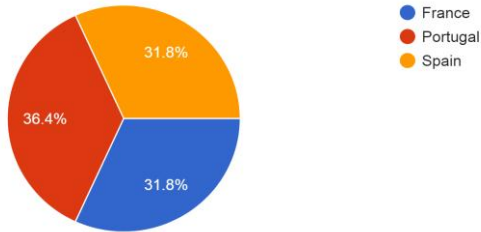

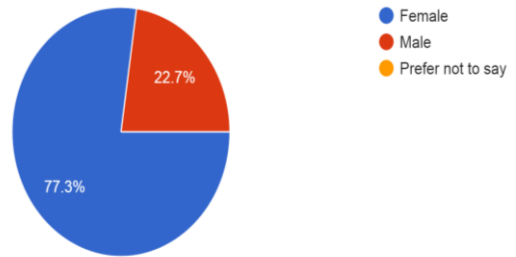

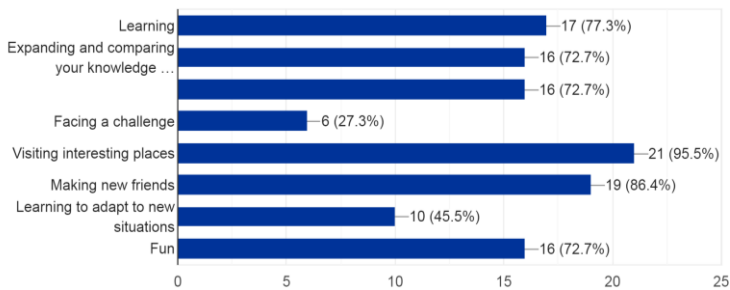
2 What is your gender?

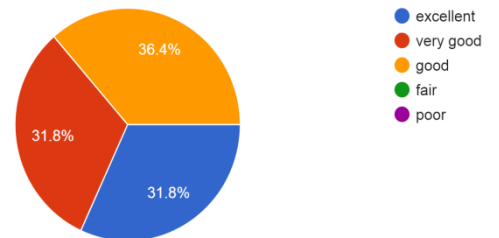

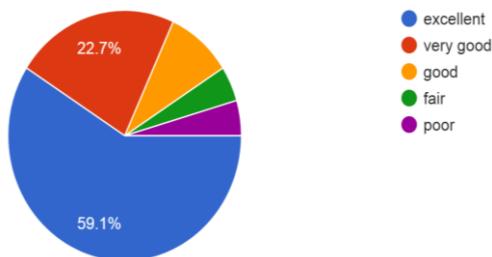

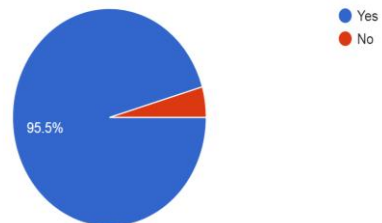

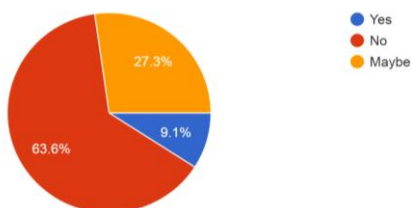

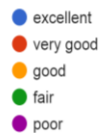

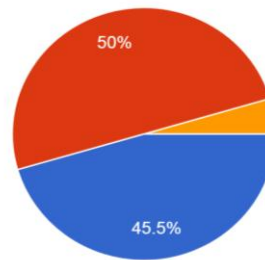

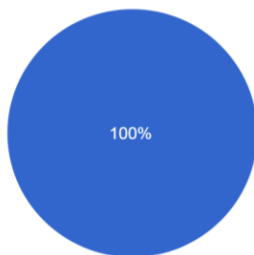

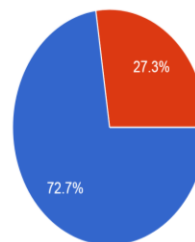
